PER CURIAM:

IT IS ORDERED that: appellant James A. Brown's unopposed Motion for Release on Conditions Instanter is GRANTED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the United States Department of Justice and the Federal Bureau of Prisons shall release James A. Brown forthwith to the custody of the United States Marshal Service, which is directed to take him before an appropriate United States Magistrate Judge, who is directed to set bail in the appropriate amount and set proper conditions for his release pending further proceedings.
