
PER CURIAM:

IT IS ORDERED that appellant William R. Fuhs's Renewed Application for Release on Conditions Pending Appeal is GRANTED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the United States Department of Justice and the Federal Bureau of Prisons shall release William R. Fuhs forthwith to the custody of the United States Marshal Service, which is directed to take him before an appropriate United States Magistrate Judge, who is directed to set bail in the appropriate amount and set proper conditions for his release pending appeal. Once the United States Magistrate Judge is satisfied that William R. Fuhs is qualified, willing, and able to meet the conditions of

his release, said William R. Fuhs will be released from United States custody pending appeal.
